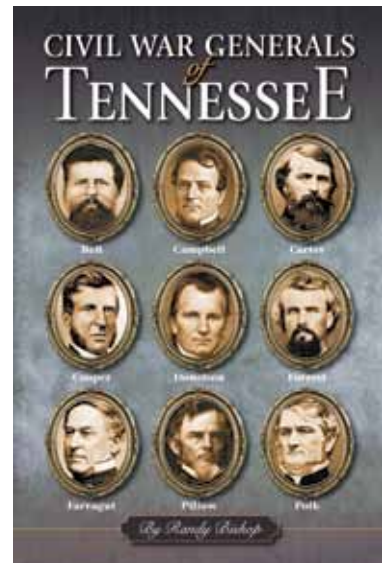

The Raiding Winter

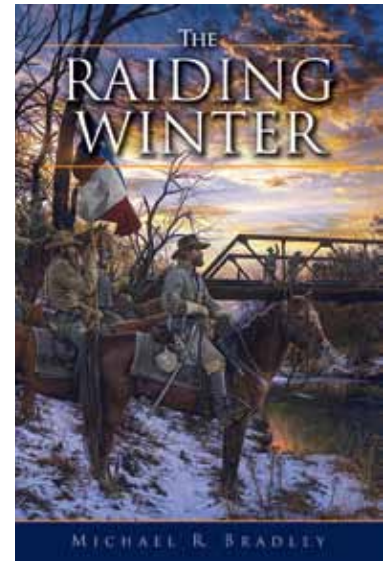
